Call to Order

Roll Call

City Manager Report:

Tornado Siren – Mayor stated that he and Kevin pulled a new quote today and it is now \$58,000. This process was started in 2022 and the current approved contract ends on June 8, 2026. We have the option to pay the increase or resubmit the contract and wait for approval. After much discussion it was recommended to add to February agenda for a vote and a budget amendment to cover the difference.

FYE 27 Budget Workshop Schedule – City Recorder Bowman suggested a workshop meeting with vendors and public to discuss wants and needs for the next fiscal year. A meeting has been scheduled for immediately following the February Commission Meeting.

Club House and Park WIFI – City Recorder Bowman discussed the request of the public renting the club house and general public using the park for a guest WIFI service. Mayor Edwards stated the club house would need a


separate internet service due to the metal building and type of walls. The cost should be around \$50. He also stated that we can talk to Cumberland Connect to see what is offered or suggested to provide a guest access park wide with our current service. Mayor Edwards made a motion to approve a new service in the Club House and to talk to CEMC for the park service, seconded by Commissioner Kirby. Roll Call Vote: Commissioner Kirby: Yes; Vice-Mayor Pettus: Yes; Mayor Edwards: Yes. Approved 3-0




